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Current Problems in Movie Productions





Tier 1 Studios Are Expensive

Tier 1 household named production studios in California are expensive to run. With expensive rents, large overhead costs for upper management, studios are looking for smaller partners to produce films at a fraction of the cost with lower overhead.

At Project Z, overhead is low with no major studio rental fees or large upper management costs.



Actors-Director Costs

Actors and directors demand top dollar for contracts with direct award contracts with Tier 1 household named production studios.

This is not the same case when actors and directors work with smaller production companies like Project Z.



Film Industry Is Behind in Al

There is no market leading technology that takes the risk of viewer expectations, that could screen reactions, expressions and emotions.



Marketing & Distribution

Marketing and Distribution fees run into the millions, sometimes in the tens of millions. This makes reaching the target viewing audience very expensive.

At Project Z, the produced film is sold to groups like Amazon, Netflix, Paramount or Universal where the cost of distribution is funded by the buyer.

Definitions





Produced by producer

A "Produced by" producer is the key individual responsible for overseeing the entire film production, managing both creative and logistical aspects, from development to completion. They handle financing, hiring, and ensure the project stays on schedule and within budget.



Executive producer

An executive producer oversees the financial and organizational aspects of a film or TV production, securing funding, managing the budget, and ensuring the project stays on track. They may also provide input on creative decisions and act as a liaison between the production team and financiers or studios.



Producer

A film producer manages the overall production of a film, overseeing everything from financing and hiring to coordinating the crew and ensuring the project is completed on time and within budget. They are responsible for both the creative and logistical aspects of the film.



Line producer

A line producer manages the day-to-day operations of a film or TV production, overseeing the budget, scheduling, and coordinating the crew to ensure the project runs smoothly on set. They focus on the logistical aspects during filming.



Smash Broadway




Smash is finally heading to Broadway.
